

<b>OT to the Rescue Services and Fee Schedule</b>		
<b>OT assessment and report</b>	Student observation, parent and teacher interview, and/or administration and scoring of appropriate assessment measures	\$400
<b>Direct OT treatment</b>	Clinic, classroom, or educationally relevant community based occupational therapy services	\$85
<b>OT consultation</b>	OT consultation refers to contact with teacher, staff, parent, or student through e-mail, phone calls, observation, or direct interaction.	\$85
<b>Multiple assessment package</b>	4 - 8 assessments in a single day. All assessments must take place in one day, at a single location. The district/organization ordering this service must provide a suitable location (a well-lit and ventilated room with reasonable climate control and child-sized table and chairs). OT to the Rescue must have permission to contact teachers and parents prior to assessments. The following rates include assessment and written report. The written report will be provided within one week of the assessment day. An OT to the Rescue representative may also be able to attend (in person or by phone) an IEP meeting to explain assessment results to the team (hourly rates apply).	\$400 Per assessment
<b>Annual progress reports and IEP or other team meeting attendance</b>	Prepare and report annual progress and new goals. Participate in team meetings, including Individualized Education Programs (IEP), Individualized Family Service Plans (IFSP), Student Study Teams (SST), Response to Intervention (RTI), or other transdisciplinary meetings.	\$85 Per hour
<b>Travel</b>	Travel time will be charged for all commutes of more than 20 minutes	\$85 Per hour
